Location of Cemetery:

US Route #60 to Kilgore, KY. Turn on SR 854 then left on 1654 [Williams Creek]. Approximately 2 ½ miles to gravel road, between Dawson Branch and Norton Branch. Norton Fire Station is just beyond turn-off on left.

Condition/Comments:

Overgrown. Cemetery plots on both sides of road way. All overgrown. Many field stones are scattered throughout the various plots. Most area's are not in straight rows but in "groups." Extractor's have labeled these "groups" as sections, beginning with the top northwestern grouping which is at the edge of the ridge [section A]. Click for map.
