Location of Cemetery:

The Iron Hill Cemetery is located on the North-South Highway 7, next to the northwest bank of Tygarts Creek. It is approximately 40 feet south of the AA Highway, from which it may be seen if you are going toward Grayson.

the cemetery off of Rt. 7 to a small farm road that leads toward Tygart Creek Bridge. Park at the end of the road, walk approximately 30 feet to the gate of the cemetery near the northwest corner.

Condition/Comments:

The cemetery is approximately 60 feet by 75 feet and is unmarked. There are 25-30 unmarked graves and stones that have been moved from this cemetery.

The following was submitted by Sherry Lowe: The AA highway did not in any way effect this cemetery and no graves were moved for the highway. There are closer to 75 graves missing from the cemetery, which is located on the edge of Tygart. A portion of the cemetery was washed away during a flood of Tygart, many years ago. The bank gave way and all the graves located on the back section simply washed down stream. This information came from my Great Uncle Hubert Burnett who owned the farm on which the cemetery is located. The surrounding farm still belongs to my family.
