**Location of Cemetery:**

Cemetery is located west of Grahn on State Highway 3298, directly across the road and in front of the Mountain Top Chapel.

**Condition/Comments:**

The cemetery begins at the edge of the Church parking lot, is fenced and well maintained. There are approximately 25 graves that are marked only with large smooth sand stones and appear to be very old, perhaps even the original section of the cemetery. Judging by the older stones that are actually monuments, these graves could date back to the mid 1870's or earlier.
