Broken stone. "Father let thy grace be given that we may meet in heaven"

Circle w/symmetrical cross in the middle present at the stone base.
SPARKS in capital on top of stone,

Roses carved in draping fashion across the top of stone.
"AT REST" Plant leaf with long petals from center.
Ivy draped at top of the headstone on the R side.
Flowers carved on upper R side of stone
