

Henry Howell, 78, Dies; Funeral Wednesday 3 p. m.

Henry Howell, 78, father of Mrs. James Land and Clarence (Shorty) Howell of this city, died at 6:20 a. m. today at the Harrisburg hospital. A heart ailment caused his death after a week's serious illness. He had been in failing health much longer than that, however.

He was a retired coal miner who came to Harrisburg in 1909 from Kentucky. He was born at Kilgore, Ky., Feb. 17, 1875. His wife, Mary, died 5 years ago.

Besides the two children in Harrisburg, he is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Edna Hurley, Lakeworth, Fla., and Mrs. Anna Montague, San Diego; a son, William E. Howell, Bristol, Pa.; seven grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren.

Mrs. Dora McNeal, Lake Orion, Mich., and Mrs. Victor Cazzell, Dugger, Ind., are his sisters.

His body is at the chapel in the Harrisburg funeral home and will remain there until Wednesday afternoon. The funeral will be held at 3 p. m. at the First Baptist church, one hour prior to which the body will lie in state at the church. The Rev. R. W. Wallis will conduct the funeral service and the Brotherhood and the J. B. Moore Sunday school class will be flower bearers. Burial will be at Sunset Lawn.
