

**Remains of John McGuire, Who Was  
Killed Here Yesterday, Taken  
Moberly, Mo.**

Grant McGuire, brother of John McGuire, who was killed by a Santa Fe train yesterday, arrived from Moberly, Mo., at noon today to care for his brother's body. Arrangements could not be made for the body to be shipped to Kentucky as was the wish of the deceased and the funeral will be held tomorrow morning. Interment in Elmwood.

The deceased was a member of the Mine Workers union. The local unions were generous in their offers of aid, but no assistance was needed.

As there is no telegraphic communication with E. K. Junction, word was sent to Geo. Castle at Grayson, Ky., which is only 3 miles from the McGuire home. Mr. Castle is a cousin of F. A. Sauer and Mrs. Sauer who was raised in Carter county, remembers the McGuire family as one of the oldest and most highly respected in Eastern Kentucky. Though the deceased met his death while trying to beat his way, he was not a bum but a hard working miner who was out of money and was trying to reach work as best he could. His companions were carpenters and were so affected by the horrible death of their comrade that they resolved to pay their way in the future. They went to Pittsburg last night after giving the railroad officials affidavits of the death of McGuire. They intend to return to Chanute and work at their trade this summer.
